Our mission: To activate young adults to exalt Christ and advance His Gospel to the multitudes, by awakening hearts to Jesus, inspiring dreams for the Kingdom, and engaging hands in the Great Commission.

Community & Discipleship: Finance & Management Interns, like all participants in OneWay's Internship & Discipleship program, will live in community housing and participate in our intensive discipleship program. We believe that all effective ministry comes out of the overflow of an intimate relationship with Jesus and a heart for His Kingdom. Our primary priority is to foster this in our interns through spiritual discipleship, teaching, mentorship, community outreach and events, prayer & worship, and sharpening peer relationships as we live and minister together in intentional community.

Finance & Management Track Responsibilities:

- Interns will help craft and implement new strategies and systems to manage the organization, using Salesforce and other tools as well as provide administrative support to every area of the ministry.
- Interns will assist in developing, documenting maintaining ministry processes and procedures
- Interns will learn from and work alongside ministry leaders in financial management and fundraising strategies for our various ministries and campaigns
- Research and find new finance platforms and streamline donor resource management process and platforms

Qualifications:

Experience in spreadsheets and clerical work, detail-oriented, can focus on many projects at one time, works well with others, drive to continually improve systems and processes.

Timeframe:

Our 2020 Summer Internship & Discipleship Program is from May 26-July 31. This is a full-time, residentially-based discipleship & work program.

Compensation: We consider all staff and interns to be on mission, and highly value the work produced by participants in our program. Thus, we provide training and assistance to raise up to **\$3,500** to cover the program cost and a personal stipend of **\$2250**.

Cost: The cost of the program is \$1250 for the summer. This cost can be covered through support raising and includes community housing for the summer, team activities and retreat trips, community meals & events, program materials & supplies, and staff administration fees.
